THE CHANGE-RYP




Greeting and salutations to all,





NOMADS CONSTITUTION EXPLAINED

HOW TO DEAL WITH MAKE-UP GAMES

REPEATED

There has been some discussion recently amongst Nomads from several Nomads clubs, regarding the playing of "MAKE-UP GAMES" to compensate for the monthly meeting games at their home clubs, that were cancelled due to the Covid lock-down during 2020.

For clarification, the following is an extract from our Nomads constitution:

- "7.3.3 A Full Member shall play in a minimum of 6 (Six) monthly meetings of his Member Club during the Club's playing year. In the event of a Full Member failing to meet this obligation and at the discretion of the Executive Committee of the Member Club, he may be offered Associate Membership or his membership may be terminated provided that:
 - 7.3.3.1 The Executive Committee of any Member Club may waive the requirements set out in 7.3.3 in the event of his Member Club being unable to accommodate him in the monthly meeting of his Club.
 - 7.3.3.2 Should a player fail to play in a monthly meeting of his Member Club but plays in any of the two preceding months, or in either of the four following months, in the monthly meeting of another Nomad Club, (whether locally or at any international Club), his obligation for that particular month shall be deemed to have been met. Such scores shall not count towards any of his Member Club's annual competitions but shall be used for handicapping. Any Nomad playing a make-up game shall be able to win as a Nomad of the day, but shall not qualify for that Club's Gold Cup Competition.
 - 7.3.3.3 Unless otherwise agreed to by the Executive Committee of the Member Club, each Full Member shall be allowed a maximum of two (2) make-up games per annum."

Your Lowveld Executive ruled that as we only played seven games in 2020, the minimum of six games could not be applied. It was also ruled that due to the danger of Covid, especially, to our older members, this would be a mitigating factor for members that do not comply with the minimum commitment of six games in the playing year.

As the April, May and June 2020 scheduled games were cancelled last year due to Covid, no game may be played to make-up for these three cancelled games as you cannot make-up a game that was never played.

If, however you missed a scheduled Lowveld game, for any reason whatever, you may play a make-up game at any other Nomads club as per the Constitution. This game then comes through on the SAMSON (Scoring and membership system of Nomads) and you will be credited a maximum of two make-up games in any one playing year.

If Nomadic duties, such as Golforama, or other exceptional circumstances caused you to miss more than two games, you may approach your committee to allow more make-up games, within the time frame allowed.

Bottom line is:

YOU MAY ONLY PLAY MAKE-UP GAMES FOR SCHEDULED GAMES MISSED AT YOUR HOME CLUB
