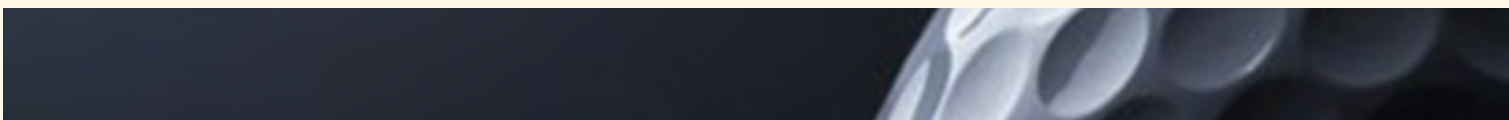
**Mbombela Golf

THE 2022 ANDREW MENTIS BENEFICIARIES

Vice-Captain, Johan Janse van Rensburg, officially launched his 2022 Andrew Mentis Nomads Foundation fundraising campaign, and his Committee is already hard at work.

Nomads is a golfing body with a mission to promote golf and foster goodwill at every possible opportunity, including assisting to welfare organisations with money raised during the year from our fundraising initiatives.

Each year, all Nomad Clubs throughout South Africa host a charity golf day or two, where they request corporate and private sponsorship. This event was initiated by Mr. Andrew Mentis, a founder Nomad in 1960, hence the name. To date Nomads have contributed in excess of R38,000,000 to charities country wide, whilst Lowveld charities have benefitted in the amount of over **R3,380,000** since 1997.

This year, the Lowveld Club has selected the following beneficiaries for 2022:

White River Hospice: A non-profit Organisation (NPO), established in 2001 by The Rotary Club of White River. They specialise in quality home-based Palliative Care, which they have provided to White River Residents over the last 20 years. They have identified the development of a step-down/inpatient care facility (adjacent to Hospice House) that will focus on, and be of service to, short-term stay patients - including those suffering from conditions such as Alzheimer's and Dementia.

White River SPCA: A non-profit Organisation (NPO) whose objects include the prevention of ill treatment of animals by promoting their good treatment by man, to take cognisance of the application of laws affecting animals and to do all things reasonably necessary for, or incidental thereto. The Society performs an important health and welfare function, not only in respect of animals but also for the wider community. They identified the following project: upgrading of animal welfare facilities to enable us to provide adequate services to the community.

The annual activities culminate with a presentation to the selected Charities at the annual Andrew Mentis golf day, which is open to all Nomads, guests and potential sponsors by invitation.

The Lowveld Andrew Mentis golf day will be held on **Sunday 13th November 2022** at White River Golf Club and we expect a full field of 128 players.

We respectfully request that you take up the opportunity to become, or obtain a sponsor for the day. Please contact Johan, or any of his Committee, for any further information or donations.

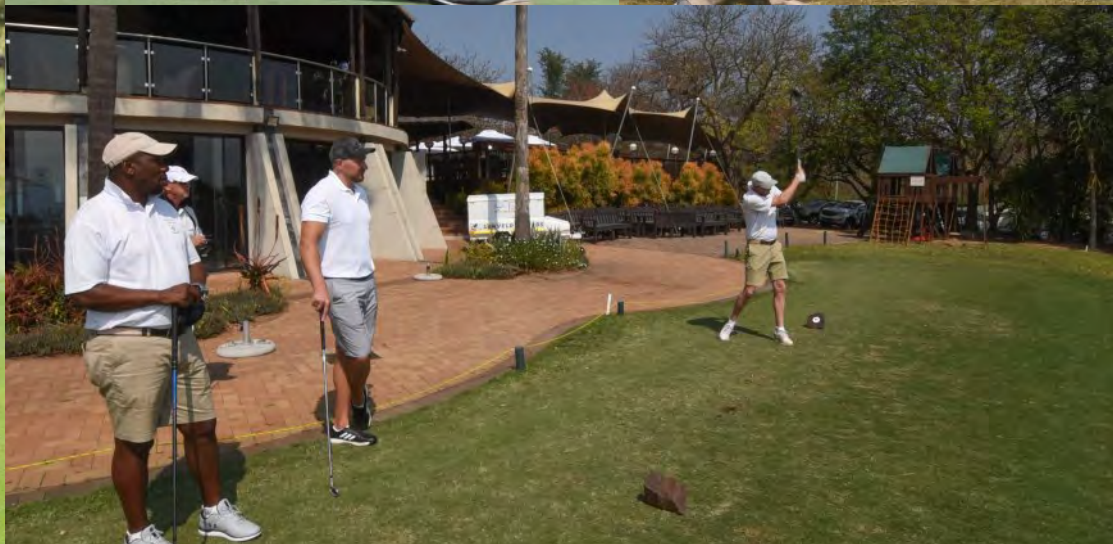

THE CHANGE-ROOM

chatterbox
what've you got to say?

Greetings and salutations to all,

Another month gone, another great day on the golf course - and what a change it was! From the lovely Kambaku layout last month, with very average scoring, to Mbombela with a great average score of almost 30.

The course was in great nick and this obviously reflected in the scores. Club General Manager, Darren Plumb and his team went the extra mile for us and we thank them for that. Once again, most of the annual competitions are as tight as a tiger, but time is running out. It is nice to see some familiar faces on the podium again after struggling with their game, but seem to be back with vengeance.

A topic that seems to have gripped and divided the international golfing world is the new LIV tour. I don't think that in the history of the game there has been so much animosity, pettiness and vindictiveness shown by any tour to another. Obviously everybody has their own opinion on the matter and I would like to share my two cents worth...

"To me it has got really personal between Greg Norman and Jay Moynahan, the PGA head. The damage has been done and a lot more of the top golfers have gone over to LIV than the PGA could have expected, and now it is damage-control to try and rescue the situation. In my opinion, the LIV has been good for the PGA guys, while the tour has magically found tens of millions to give away in prize money. They are also having "no cut" events at the end of the year and now all the golfers are getting \$500,000 to make it through the year. None of which would have happened if LIV had not taken off.



The sad thing has been how petty the PGA has been regarding the treatment of the golfers. Things like, Cam Smith having his parking spot removed from the players championship parking lot - how petty can you get? There is going to be a watered-down Presidents Cup and even with their best team they were always going to struggle, and you then have to think that if the LIV golfers are banned from the majors is it really a test of the best golfers in the world.

Rory has been very vocal and in my opinion, flipping annoying with his comments, but if he does not make a cut he still gets his \$20 or \$30 million in sponsorship deals, so it's easy to be vocal. Obviously money played a huge roll in most of the golfers decisions to move over, but it must be hard to say "no", when they dangle a \$50 million carrot in your face."

Either way, it is sad that there has been so much animosity and it has divided the golfing world like it has. I have contacted Greg Norman myself and I have made it very clear that I am available, but I can only assume that he has lost my number, because he has not got back to me yet. I have not lost hope and I continue to practice - once a month, regularly in case the phone call comes.
